1. Dressing themselves:
 - putting on coats

6. Washing hands with soap.

8. Telling first and last name when asked.
9. Writing their first name.
10. Cleaning up after themselves.
11. Raising hands to ask for help (especially in the lunchroom).

14. Having basic social skills of being with others.
